# NANDHINI

Ten year old Nandhini, along with her siblings, attends tutoring classes every evening at one of our CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTERS. Her family practices all the Hindu customs and rituals, including sacrificing animals and drinking their blood. Her father has turned to alcohol and barely supports his family. Helpless to answer the children's cries for food each day, her mother has become very distressed, even as she continues to call on the Hindu gods to rid them of poverty.



The family opposed the children coming to the center for some time, but eventually relented. MVN provides the children with at least one meal, which encourages and motivates them to study. The children lag behind in their studies due to poor concentration and limited memory ability caused by malnourishment. The "meal program" provided at these centers, not only fights their hunger, but is also a means of getting these children to attend. Currently, Nandhini and her siblings are still required to participate in the Hindu ceremonies and rituals, even though they do not want to do so. They cry and ask for our prayer support. So many children and their families are living under the bondages of sin, curse and poverty. We must bring transformation in their lives and bring their families to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. We are in continual need of funds to provide food and tutoring so we can impact their lives and their society in Jesus' name.

# ANBU MATHEW

Although Anbu Mathew was born into a Hindu family, he was educated at a Christian hostel where he was taught Bible stories and learned about the love of Jesus. In his 12th grade year, he developed a life-threatening brain tumor. He prayed to Jesus for healing and vowed to worship HIM all the days of his life if he could be healed. His operation was a success and Anbu began attending church regularly, meditating on God's word and surrendered his life to Christ. After a few years, he began drifting away from God and living an ungodly life. Once again, he became very ill and once more he cried out to the Lord, asking for forgiveness and healing. When he was healed this time, he dedicated his life to ministry.

He's been mocked and ostracized by his family because of his choice to serve God. But he has remained faithful and his ministry is thriving. His wife, also active in the ministry, offers prayer support and counseling for the women.
